Changi Airport Sees Highest Number of Passenger Movements in 7 Months

More than 3 million passengers pass through Changi in July 2006

Passenger volumes at Changi Airport have reached a new high in 2006 – 3.05 million passengers were handled in July. This represents a 5.2 per cent increase over the same period last year. More than 100,000 passenger movements were recorded every weekend in July. Compared to June – the previous record for highest monthly traffic in 2006 – an additional 69,000 passengers went through Changi in July.

For the first 7 months of the year, passenger traffic totaled 19.9 million, up 8.5 per cent for the same period last year.

Cargo movements registered a 2.2 per cent growth over July 2005. Almost 158,300 tonnes were processed through Changi.

As at 1 August 2006, Changi Airport is served by some 80 airlines with over 4,000 flights connecting to more than 180 cities in 57 countries.
